# **CATEGORIES OF PERSONAL INFORMATION**

The following are categories of information relating to an individual, whether it relates to their private, professional or public life. Categories are not exclusive. Data may transcend multiple information categories.









## **KNOWLEDGE & BELIEF SENSITIVE**

Information about what a person knows or believes. i.e. Religious beliefs,

philosophical beliefs, thoughts, what they know and don't know, what someone thinks.



# **HISTORY**

Information about an individual's personal history. i.e. Events that happened in a person's life, either to them or just around them which might have influenced them (WWII. 9/11).







#### AUTHENTICATING

**PREFERENCE** 

or interests.

Information used to authenticate an individual with something they know. i.e. Passwords, PIN, mother's maiden name.

Information about an individual's preference

or interests, i.e. Opinions, intentions, preferences





Information about an individual's purchasing, spending or income. i.e. Purchases, sales, credit, income, loan rec-ords, transactions, taxes, purchases, and spending habits.





# **EXTERNAL**

#### Information about an individual's reputation with regards to money. i.e. Credit records, creditworthiness, credit standing, credit capacity.





# **IDENTIFYING**

Information that uniquely or semi-uniquely identifies a specific individual. i.e. Name. username, unique identifi-er, government-issued identification, picture, biometric data.







# ETHNICITY SENSITIVE

Information that describes an individual's origins and lineage. i.e. Race, national or ethnic origin, languages spoken, dialects, accents.

# **PROFESSIONAL** Information about an individual's educational







# SEXUAL SENSITIVE

Information that describes an individual's sexual life. i.e. Gender identity, preferences, proclivities, fetishes, his-tory, etc.

# SENSITIVE CRIMINAL

Information about an individual's criminal activity. i.e. Convictions, charges, pardons.





# **BEHAVIORAL**

**DEMOGRAPHIC** 

Information that describes an individual's behavior or activity, online or off. i.e. Browsing behavior, call logs, links clicked, demeanor, attitude

MEDICAL AND HEALTH SENSITIVE

Information that describes an individual's health,

medical conditions or health care. i.e. Physical and mental

health, drug test results, disabilities, family or individual health

history, health records, blood type, DNA code, prescriptions.

Information that describes an individual's characteristics

shared with others. i.e. Age ranges, physical traits, in-come

# SENSITIVE PUBLIC LIFE

Information about an individual's public life. i.e. Character, general reputation, social status, marital status, religion, political affiliations, interactions,



communications meta-data.



## **FAMILY**

Information about an individual's family and relationships Family structure, siblings, offspring, marriages, divorces, relationships



# SOCIAL NETWORK

Information about an individual's friends or social connections. i.e. Friends, connections, acquaintances,



associates, group membership.

#### SENSITIVE COMMUNICATION Information communicated

from or to an individual. i.e. Telephone recordings, voicemail, email.





## PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTIC

Information that describes an individual's physical appearance. i.e. Height, weight, age, hair color, skin tone, tattoos, gender, piercings





### **COMPUTER DEVICE**

Information about a device that an individual uses for personal use (even part-time or with others). i.e. IP ad-dress, Mac address, browser fingerprint.




### CONTACT

Information that provides a mechanism for contacting an individual. i.e. Email address, physical address, tele-phone number



### LOCATION SENSITIVE

Information about an individual's location. i.e. Country, GPS coordinates, room number
